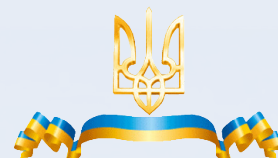

Nowadays the issue of sustainable development is one of the most urgent in Ukraine and in the world. Sustainable development is a process of transformation in the sphere of physical culture and sport on the basis of harmonization of social, economic and environmental components, which has undergone a certain historical development.

In 1994 the International Olympic Committee established the Commission on Sustainable Development and Legacy; moreover, the Agreement on joint activities with the United Nations Environment

Program was concluded. In 1996 the protection of the environment was proclaimed to be the third pillar of Olympism in addition to sport and culture, therefore, the relevant amendments were introduced to the Olympic Charter. In 1999 «The Olympic Agenda for XXI Century» was adopted, which contains the set of actions to be taken in the field of sustainable development.

The National University of Ukraine on Physical Education and Sport in cooperation with the National Olympic Committee of Ukraine, several ministries and departments has launched a series of initiatives aimed at implementing the concept of sustainable development in sports sphere. Due to the support of the Ministry of Ukraine on Education and Science, the scientific topic «Theoretical and Methodical Principles for the Implementation of Sustainable Development Concept in Physical Culture and Sport» is being developed. On the basis of this scientific topic, training of scientific and pedagogical staff in both postgraduate and doctoral studies is being conducted; the environmental issues are being studied by the undergraduates; as well as «Ecology of Sports» specialty has been introduced as a Master's course.

Today we create a scientific platform that will allow us to apply the accumulated international experience in solving environmental problems related to sports activities, implementation of environmental projects in different countries and spheres of physical culture and sport. It is especially topical for our country taking into account preparation for 2018 European Combat Sports Junior Championship, as well as the opportunity to host 2019 European Basketball and Figure Skating Championships in Kyiv, and 2021 World Summer Students' Universiade.

So, I wish all the participants of the Conference fruitful work, interesting discussions, inspiration, new ideas and scientific achievements to honour Ukraine!
